# LI ZHANG Chinese Instruments

Li Zhang, is an erhu instructor at the Laurier Academy of Music and Arts (LAMA), the music director and erhuist of the Grand River Chinese Orchestra, and the erhuist of the Qi Ensemble. She began her musical journey at the age of four in her hometown of Beijing, China, studying erhu with renowned erhu masters Xunfeng Jiang and Yongning Liu. She expanded her musical knowledge and received a BA (2007) and MA (2009) from Wuhan University. She also participated in the cultural exchange program of Université Paris Diderot-Paris VII and Wuhan University in Paris, France.

She won multiple National Music Competitions, including the National Chinese Music Competition as the erhu soloist in the Fiddle Concerto "Medley of Five Strings", First Place in 2006, and the People's Scholarship in China (2007, 2008). She was invited to the Great Hall of the People Concert and performed

for the Chinese President, and was invited to perform for national leaders at the Beijing Concert Hall and Zhongnanhai, Beijing.

She was the concertmaster of the Beijing Jinfan Chinese Orchestra (1998), Wuhan University Chinese Orchestra (2005), and Waterloo Chinese Orchestra (2014), as well as a guest musician in organizations such as the Canadian Dongfang Chinese Orchestra. Other than erhu, Li also has collaborated with the Wuhan University Symphony Orchestra and Beijing Xiaobaishu National Orchestra to perform famous traditional jinghu and banhu repertoire such as "Deep Night", "Galloping Steeds", "The White-Haired Girl", and "Days of Emancipation". She also participated in music exchanges and performances in Europe, America, and Asia.



Carole Anderson is a life-long choral educator passionate about the transformative power of singing in community and enthusiastic about creating ecellent musical experiences for children and youth. Carole is the Artistic Director of Young Voices Toronto, a vibrant children and youth choir organization in Toronto's west end and currently conducting three of YVT's six ensembles.

During her 35-year teaching career Carole taught music at all grade levels and was a music consultant in both Brant and Peel Districts. Her middle school choral and concert band ensembles were recognized for excellence at local, regional, and national festivals. In 2012, Carole was recognized for her contributions to music education receiving an Honorary Life Membership from the Ontario Music Educators' Association.

From 2006 - 2020, Carole served as an Associate Conductor with the Toronto Children's Chorus (TCC) where she conducted three choirs. As a member of the TCC's Artistic Staff, Carole was part of 8 international and 2 national tours that covered Europe, South Africa, Russia and the Baltics, South America, Bahamas, New Zealand, Australia, and the USA.

Carole received her Bachelor of Music at Western University where she studied choral conducting with Deral Johnson. From 2013 - 2018, she was a member of the Board of Cirectors for Choirs Ontario, with responsibility for the Ontario Youth Choir. Carole continues to serve as a choral adjudicator, guest conductor, and guest lecturer.





Emily Chiang is a Toronto based pianist and teacher. Born in Taiwan, she made her debut at the age of six, and has since been active as a recitalist, performing locally in Toronto and internationally. She has performed as a guest soloist with the University of Toronto Symphony Orchestra, Lima Symphony Orchestra and the Concordia College Symphony Orchestra. A passionate chamber musician, Emily has also performed at Winspear Centre and Banff Centre for the Arts and was a fellow in Toronto Summer Chamber Institute in 2012. She has many ongoing projects including an upcoming piano duo recital and piano-violin duo recitals in Toronto in 2024.

Equally dedicated as a teacher, she is currently on the piano faculty at the University of Toronto. In addition, she has served as an adjudicator for OYMI Music Festival and has recently given a guest lecture and masterclasses at Presbyterian College in South Carolina.

Emily earned a Bachelor of Music degree from the Oberlin College Conservatory of Music studying under Alvin Chow and subsequently completed her Master of Music at the Indiana University working with Menahem Pressler and Arnaldo Cohen. In 2013, she completed a Doctor of Musical Arts degree at the University of Toronto under the tutelage of Marietta Orlov.



Canadian pianist Joy Lee enjoys a multi-faceted career as a collaborative pianist, teacher, soloist and adjudicator. She is a passionate advocate of music and has performed at events and venues ranging from the Canadian Embassy in Washington D.C. (as part of US President Barack Obama's inauguration celebration), to the Banff Centre for the Arts, to performance spaces in Inuvik and Yellowknife in Canada's Northwest Territories.

Dr. Lee received BMus and MMus in solo piano from the University of Toronto and her love of the voice and its literature led her to pursue her second MMus in collaborative piano studies at the University of Michigan (Ann Arbor), as well as her Doctorate at the University of Toronto.

She is a Lecturer of Music and Worship Arts at Tyndale University and is dedicated to educating the next generation of musicians. She is a winner Prize (University of Toronto) and 2017 Eckhardt-Gramatté National Music

of the prestigious 2018 Gwendolyn Williams Koldofsky Prize (University of Toronto) and 2017 Eckhardt-Gramatté National Music Competition (2nd) for her collaborative work.

In April 2023, she made her Carnegie Hall (NYC) debut as part of the Canada at Carnegie Concert. Dr. Lee and Stéphanie McKay-Turgeon, soprano, were invited to research and perform the music of the French composer, Henri Dutilleux, at the Maison Dutilleux-Joy in Candes-Saint- Martin, France, in November 2023.

Currently, Dr. Lee collaborates with the Amadeus Choir of Greater Toronto, Graduate Choral Conducting Seminar and MacMillan Singers (University of Toronto), as well as Tyndale Community Choir (Tyndale University), and serves on the Board of Directors of the North Toronto Songbirds.

Praised for "her sweet and distinct tone...breathtaking in colour" (Whole Note), Dr. Swinden embraces a multi-faceted career as a performer, pedagogue, and scholar. Laurel has been an invited performer and teacher in Argentina, Peru, Belgium, National Flute Association Conventions (USA), the Sichuan Conservatory (China), Canadian Flute Conventions, International Festival of Books and Arts (USA) and the Perimeter Institute (CAN). Dr. Swinden's Celebrating Women! and Celebrating Canadian Women! recordings with pianist Stephanie Mara promote works for flute by women composers, funded by the Canada Council, Ontario Arts Council and Waterloo Region Arts Council and can be heard on Spotify, Naxos and CBC Music. She was an Artistic Advisor and performer of an International Online Festival of Flute Music by Women Composers (2022) funded by FACTOR and the Canada Council. As part of the Flute New Music Consortium, Laurel co-commissions and

premieres new works for flute. In addition to positions as Principal Flute of the Stratford Symphony Orchestra and Assistant Principal Flute/Piccolo of the Scarborough Philharmonic, Dr. Swinden has performed the New World Symphony, Memphis Symphony, Mississippi Symphony, Symphony of the Americas and in Ontario with the London Sinfonia, Kingston Symphony, Windsor Symphony, Toronto Sinfonietta and Etobicoke Philharmonic. Laurel serves on the National Flute Association Pedagogy Committee. Past positions include Visiting Assistant Professor of Flute at the University of Nebraska Omaha, and adjunct Assistant Professor at Western University. She has served as a juror for the Ontario Arts Council, the NFA Myrna Brown International Scholarship competition Dr. Swinden examines for the Royal Conservatory of Music, the Glenn Gould Professional School and adjudicates at festivals across North and South America.
