French Horn - Graded Classes

- 1. Refer to Rules 11, 12, 13, 18, 19, 22, 23, 24, 25, 49, 53, 54, 55, 65 and 80. Read all Syllabus rules with care.
- 2. Selections do not need to be memorized, but it is strongly encouraged.
- 3. **NEW:** Participants may enter a class more than once as long as different repertoire is entered. A separate registration is required for each entry.
- 4. A piece of music, whether prescribed or own choice, cannot be used by a competitor in more than one class.
- 5. To be eligible for a scholarship, competitors must enter a minimum of TWO classes and receive a minimum mark of 85.
- 6.Da capo and dal segno signs must be played. Repeats should NOT be played unless otherwise indicated in either the RCM or CC Syllabus.
- 7. Performance times MUST be included on the entry form.
- 8. Participants have the option to participate either "in person" or "virtually". This decision must be made at the time of registration.
- 9. Participants who choose the virtual option will be responsible for arranging to have a video recording made of their performance and for creating a YouTube channel that can be shared with the Toronto Kiwanis Festival Office via the online registration system.
- 10. All classes in this section are eligible to proceed to the Provincial level of competition which will be held in Kitchener-Waterloo, June 9-14, 2025, upon adjudicator recommendation. *Participants should be aware that two (2) pieces are required for the Provincial Finals and that the Provincial's registration deadline will be March 30, 2025.*
