Mixed Instrumentation

1. Refer to Rules 11, 12, 13, 18, 19, 22, 23, 24, 25, 49, 53, 54, 55, 65 and 80. Read all Syllabus rules with care.
2. Own choice. Time limit of 10 minutes for all classes, includes assembly, tuning, warm-up and performance.
3. **Any combination of instruments and/or voices**
4. Piano accompaniment is permitted for duets and trios.
5. Standard Chamber repertoire for trios and quartets is not permitted in these classes. Chamber groups should enter classes 07101, 07102 or 07103.
6. The Festival does not make music stands available to competitors in solo or small group classes.
7. Performance times **MUST** be included on the entry form.
8. Participants have the option to participate either "in person" or "virtually". This decision must be made at the time of registration.
9. Participants who choose the virtual option will be responsible for arranging to have a video recording made of their performance and for creating a YouTube channel that can be shared with the Toronto Kiwanis Festival Office via the online registration system.
10. All classes in this section are eligible to proceed to the Provincial level of competition upon adjudicator recommendation. *Participants should be aware that this is a virtual competition and that two (2) pieces are required for the Provincial Finals. The Provincial registration deadline for choirs will be May 12, 2025.*
