BIPOC Composers

- 1. Refer to Rules 11, 12, 13, 18, 19, 22, 23, 24, 25, 49, 53, 54, 55, 65 and 80. Read all Syllabus rules with care.
- 2. Pieces selected must be composed by a BIPOC Composer.
- 3. Pieces may not be used in any other classes.
- 4.NEW: Participants may enter a class more than once as long as different repertoire is entered. A separate registration is required for each entry.
- 5. A piece cannot be used by a competitor in more than one class. Repertoire which does not coincide with stated categories will result in disqualification. See Rule 25.
- 6. To be eligible for a scholarship, competitors must enter a minimum of TWO classes and receive a minimum mark of 85.
- 7. Performance times MUST be included on the entry form.
- 8. Participants who choose the virtual option will be responsible for arranging to have a video recording made of their performance and for creating a YouTube channel that can be shared with the Toronto Kiwanis Festival Office via the online registration system.
