Concertos

- 1. Refer to Rules 11, 12, 13, 18, 19, 22, 23, 24, 25, 49, 53, 54, 55, 65 and 80. Read all Syllabus rules with care.
- 2. Really all Syllabus rules and regulations with care.
- 3. Own choice of any concerto with mvt. requirements listed in each class. Please note that the Italian Concerto by J.S. Bach is not permitted in this section.
- 4. Competitors who are playing at the ARCT level or above must enter the Open class regardless of age.
- 5. Orchestral part to be played on second piano.
- 6.A competitor in any concerto class may also act as accompanist for another competitor.
- 7. Cadenzas where supplied, must be played.
- 8.NEW: Participants may enter a class more than once as long as different repertoire is entered. A separate registration is required for each entry.
- 9. A piece cannot be used by a competitor in more than one class. Repertoire which does not coincide with stated categories will result in disgualification. See Rule 25.
- 10. To be eligible for a scholarship, competitors must enter a minimum of two classes and receive a minimum mark of 85.
- 11. Participants have the option to participate either "in person" or "virtually". This decision must be made at the time of registration.
- 12. Participants who choose the virtual option will be responsible for arranging to have a video recording made of their performance and for creating a YouTube channel that can be shared with the Toronto Kiwanis Festival Office via the online registration system.

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13. All classes in this section are eligible to proceed to the Provincial level of competition which will be held in Kitchener-Waterloo, June 9-14, 2025, upon adjudicator recommendation. *Participants should be that the Provincial's registration deadline will be March 30, 2025.*

| 10140 - Open - ARCT Level and Above Minimum of two consecutive movements of a piano concerto, with cadenza if applicable, or a through composed single movement concerto, or a complete concerto if it fits within the time limit. Competitors playing at the ARCT level or above must enter this class regardless of age. Time limit: 35 minutes | \$57.00 |
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| 10141 - Advanced - Ages 19 to 28 Own choice of one or two (consecutive) movements of a piano concerto, with cadenza if applicable, or a through composed single movement concerto. Time limit: 30 minutes | \$57.00 |
| 10142 - Senior - Ages 17-18 Own choice of one or two (consecutive) movements of a piano concerto, with cadenza if applicable, or a through composed single movement concerto. Time limit: 25 minutes | \$57.00 |
| 10143 - Intermediate - Level 9 and Above - Ages 15-16 Own choice of one or two (consecutive) movements of a piano concerto, with cadenza if applicable, or a through composed single movement concerto. Time limit: 20 minutes | \$57.00 |
| 10144 - Intermediate - Level 8 and Below - Ages 15-16 Own choice of one or two (consecutive) movements of a piano concerto, with cadenza if applicable, or a through composed single movement concerto. Time limit: 15 minutes | \$54.00 |
| 10145 - Junior - Level 9 and Above - Ages 13-14 Own choice of one or two (consecutive) movements of a piano concerto, with cadenza if applicable, or a through composed single movement concerto. Time limit: 20 minutes | \$57.00 |
