Ukulele - Duets or Trios

- 1. Refer to Rules 11, 12, 13, 18, 19, 22, 24, 49, 52, 64 and 80. Read all Syllabus rules with care.
- 2. Competitors must enter the class corresponding to the age of the oldest member of the duet/trio.
- 3. Memorization is optional but highly recommended.
- 4.NEW:Participants may enter a class more than once as long as different repertoire is entered. A separate registration is required for each entry.
- 5. A piece cannot be used by a competitor in more than one class. Repertoire which does not coincide with stated categories will result in disqualification. See Rule 25.
- 6. To be eligible for a scholarship, competitors must enter a minimum of two classes and receive a minimum mark of 85.
- 7. Da capo and dal segno signs must be played. Repeats should NOT be played unless otherwise indicated in either the RCM or CC Syllabus.
- 8. Performance times MUST be included on the entry form.
- 9. Participants have the option to participate either "in person" or "virtually". This decision must be made at the time of registration.
- 10. Participants who choose the virtual option will be responsible for arranging to have a video recording made of their performance and for creating a YouTube channel that can be shared with the Toronto Kiwanis Festival Office via the online registration system.
